VERDURA: A NEW WORLD-CLASS GOLF DESTINATION

Three spectacular world-class new golf courses have been built at Verdura, one of very few sites on the rugged, rolling island of Sicily where such an opportunity is possible.

California-based Kyle Phillips has created two exciting 18-hole championship courses and a nine-hole course that meander around indigenous orange and olive groves, using terrain that undulates from mountain foothills down to the Mediterranean seashore.

Phillips, who designed the stunning Kingsbarns Links just outside St Andrews in Scotland, and also the immaculate parkland courses at The Grove in Hertfordshire, as well as numerous US projects, is renowned for preserving and accentuating the essential character of the site, through his creative use of both natural and man-made landforms.

The East Course is 6,686 meters long and the West Course is 6,692 meters from the championship tees; the Short Course, a nine-hole par-3, is 913 meters. There is also a Composite Championship Course made up of holes from the East and West, should a professional championship be staged in the future, measured at 6,707 meters.

Each hole on the East and West has five tee positions to choose from: the minimum length of the East is 4,894 meters and the West 5,120 meters.

Tee times are arranged at 12-minute intervals to ensure free-flowing play, and each day one of the courses will be dedicated to two-ball play only. Golfers can choose between electric golf carts or hand-drawn trolleys; a caddy program will be introduced at a later stage.







Practice facilities are every bit as excellent as the courses and include a double-ended driving range with 75 meter wide tees providing the perfect hitting direction away from the sun. Other practice facilities include three chipping and putting greens and three bunkers. Complimentary Callaway balls are provided for practicing.





The clubhouse, built around a small piazza, houses a pro shop which sells equipment and clothing from luxury golf brands; a restaurant and bar overlooking one of the 18th holes; male and female changing rooms with showers and lockers. Clubs, trolleys and carts can be rented, and complimentary club and shoe

cleaning and bag storage will be part of the very personal, 'private club' service that visitors will enjoy here.

GENERAL INFORMATION

We have deliberately not set out rigid Golf Rules and Regulations in an attempt to maximize the enjoyment and emotions experienced by our golfing guests. However, to ensure both the Health and Safety of all whilst respecting both the Rules and Etiquette of Golf and all users of the Verdura golf facilities, we ask that you please adhere to the following guidelines.

Tee times: must be booked in advance to ensure course availability. If not already done on the advance Golf Reservation Form, please call the Golf Shop on ext. 2134 to book or alter tee times.

Handicap: To access the golf courses we ask that you have a maximum certified handicap of 36 or have proof of membership of a recognized golf club or national Golf Federation. Please present either at the Golf Shop on arrival or send scanned copy with the attached tee time Reservation Form.

Dress code is relaxed 'Resort Wear' but should be golf orientated with denim not being acceptable. Shoes should be specifically designed for golf with Soft Spikes or totally flat tennis shoes.

No smoking: A strict policy is enforced due to the high risk of fire from combustible grasses.

Golf carts may only be operated by 18 years older or those holding a current driving license. They are only for use on turf grass and may not, under any circumstance, be used on other surfaces such as roads or for Resort transportation after golf. We ask that you please return to the cart staging area at the Golf Club immediately upon completion of your round.

Jogging, walking or cycling is not permitted on the golf courses due to a very high risk of injury from errant golf shots. There is a designated route for all these activities and we ask that you adhere closely to it

Each day, one of the golf courses shall be designated as a Two Ball course and we shall alternate courses each day.






Two balls play may start on the FOUR BALL Course of the day but have no right to be let through, or pressurize slower four ball games in front.

Children are certainly more than welcome but must adhere to the general golf etiquette as written in the Rules of Golf. Children should not be left unattended in any golf area due to risk of injury.

Driving range balls must not be removed from the practice facility or used on the golf courses.

Single golfers may be paired up, only if requested in advance, by the Golf Shop. Please call 2134 if you wish this to occur.
